- ✓ **Class B uniform** **
 - ✓ Official 109 red hat
 - ✓ Green 109 T-shirt (*only GREEN 109 T-shirts count as part of Class B uniform, not tan or Palace Station shirts* – full Class B uniforms required any time scout leaves Campsite 19)
- ✓ Hiking Boots
- ✓ Camp Shoes (tennis shoes will do)
- ✓ Official Scout Socks (2 pair min.)
- ✓ Regular Socks (4 pair min.)
- ✓ Extra Underwear (5 min.)
- ✓ Extra Class B T-Shirts (up to 7 if you have them)
- ✓ Pants (1-2 pair)
- ✓ Shorts (official Scout if you have them)
- ✓ Belt
- ✓ Bandanna
- ✓ Sleeping Clothes
- ✓ Swim Suit
- ✓ Jacket or Wind breaker
